Please label these items

To bring everyday:

-1 child in weather appropriate clothes that can get messy, muddy and safe(this includes shoes they can climb and run in and when it's cold and snowy boots, snow pants, coats, mittens and hats-we will go outside everyday)

-1 Backpack or school bag(large enough to hold a folder)

To leave in cubby and replace or wash as needed:

-1 change of clothes including socks(we get messy, we get wet, we have accidents)

-1 small blanket/pillow that can fit in a backpack for rest time

To bring for individual child projects:

-1 white child t-shirt (please buy large so it will fit your child all year-they grow fast and a lot this year!)

-1 family photo(this is optional however we would love to have hanging in our rooms to bridge the home and school life-we also can snap a quick photo at drop off or pick up if you would prefer)

-1 small houseplant (that will remain in the classroom and will be your child's responsibility to care for, check that the plant is fairly easy to care for and child friendly)

-1 notebook or journal(we prefer blank pages)

Occasionally, a teacher will reach out for other additional items throughout the year to engage and continue the exploration. We also know with your help we can make your child's experience that much richer. We realize time and money are precious and appreciate any contributions we receive. We will offer other additional ways to help support us if you are interested, including projects in the classroom and even take home projects, if you are willing or have a special skill you think we may be able to utilize, just let us know.

For classroom use including sensory experiences: (please note the options and sizes)

1 box of crayola markers (fat or thin), crayons (fat or thin) or colored pencils

1 watercolor set

1 bottle of glue or 2 glue sticks

1 box of Kleenex or Box of storage bags (gallon size)

1 roll of masking tape or roll of scotch tape

1 bag of flour (5 lbs.) or 1 bottle of vegetable oil (32 ozs.)

1 small container of cream of tartar (1.5 ozs.) (found in the baking aisle)

2-3 containers of foamy shaving cream (no gel)

1 box baking soda (16 ozs.)or 1 bottle of vinegar (16 or 32 ozs.)

1 box of cornstarch (14-16 ozs.), 1 container of corn meal (16 or 24 ozs.) or 1 container of oats(18 - 24 ozs.)
