Expedition Kick-Off

All of our classrooms are getting started on our first Learning Expeditions! This is our signature curriculum structure that makes learning come alive for students. Expect to see information from your child's crew leader about these expeditions. Here are the topics we're learning about:

ECE - Portrait of An Artist

K/1 - Diggers, Flyers, Crawlers (All about insects!)

2nd/3rd - Whirl, Pop. Whoosh! (Simple machines)

Dismissal / Pick Up

Thank you for your help during our after school pick up times. As a reminder:

- To keep traffic moving, you may not park or leave your car unattended along the sidewalk in front of the school. Unattended cars may be ticketed. (Cars may be parked beyond the crosswalk to the south)
- Please continually pull up as far as possible
- We advise a right turn exits only during dismissal to alleviate traffic. To go North on Havana, please access from Girard and turn left on Galena or Dayton

What is "Crew"?

The foundation of a successful school is a strong school community that brings out the best in students and staff. An EL school culture is planned for, developed and sustained through practices that bring the community together, promote shared understandings and encourage all community members to become "crew, not passengers." Students in EL schools are known well and supported by adults. A "crew" is a group of people who work closely together, like on a ship. In a "crew", everyone takes an active role. "Crew Leaders" are our teachers and adults in the building who lead the crew along and motivate them to do their best.

We use "Crew" to allow students to build positive relationship with their peers and with their crew leader (teacher). Crew meetings are held at the beginning and the end of the day. Crew meetings provide a time dedicated to relationship building among students and adults. Crew meetings also provide a check-in on how the class is doing in terms of character and academic progress, and how well individuals are doing.

At Shoemaker, our Crew meetings are held from 9:05 - 9:35 AM and 3:45 - 4:00 PM daily. We invite you to come be a part of your child's crew to see what we are learning.
